

CRITTER CREW: RABBIT IS RIGHT


A tale of teamwork



It was springtime, and everyone in the critter crew was playing together in the Friendship Forest.




It was an ideal time to start a garden. Rabbit jumps up on a stump and announces her plan for a perfect garden.

She has sampled and found the yummiest crops to grow.




She has read gardening books and found the easiest seeds to grow.


The critters are very excited to start a garden together, and they start raising their hands with ideas.

Sloth swings with excitement and says; "We should grow apples!" Rabbit ignores him and continues with her perfect plan. Fun fact: apples are ripest in the fall.







Rabbit pauses from explaining her plan, and looks around to find that all of her friends have disappeared.






Rabbit is right. She has a perfect plan. But she needs something more than to be right. Rabbit needs teamwork.

The friends get excited, and all spread out to scout for all the seeds that are needed.




Together, all of the friends vote on a location for their garden.
