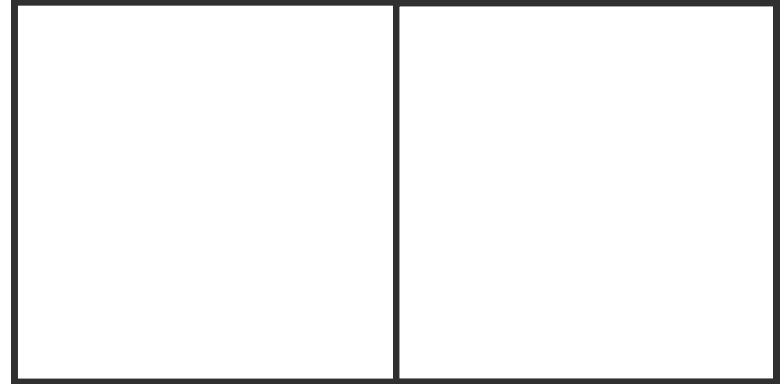

It was a beautiful day, and all of the critter friends were playing together in the forest.

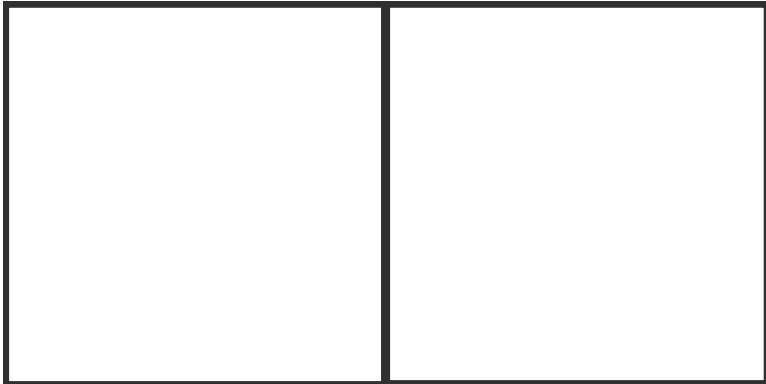

The crew notices Hedgehog's sadness and decides to help.

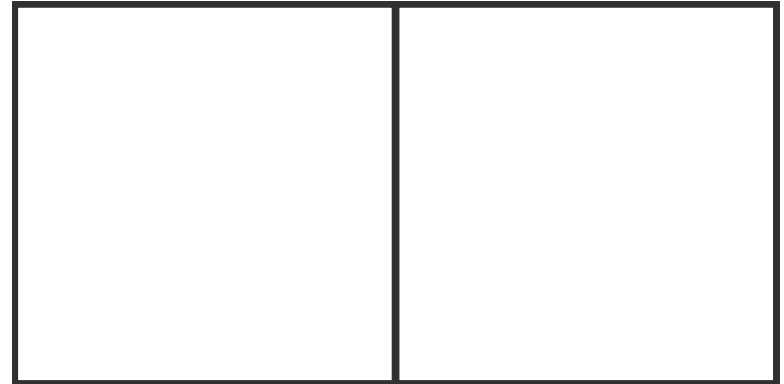

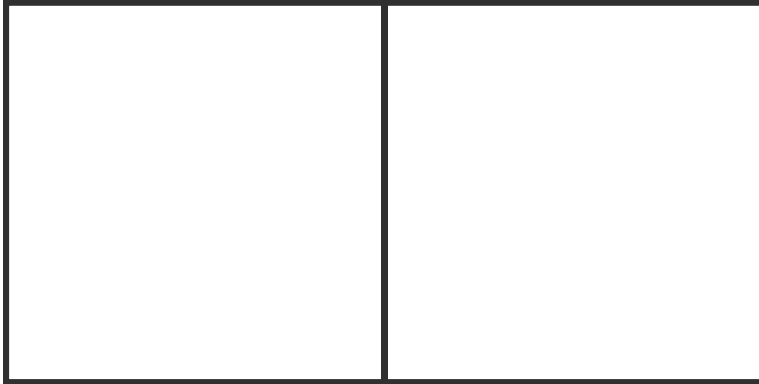
Rabbit, the energetic adventurer, says "Sometimes an adventure can chase away the blues. Lets go on a hike."

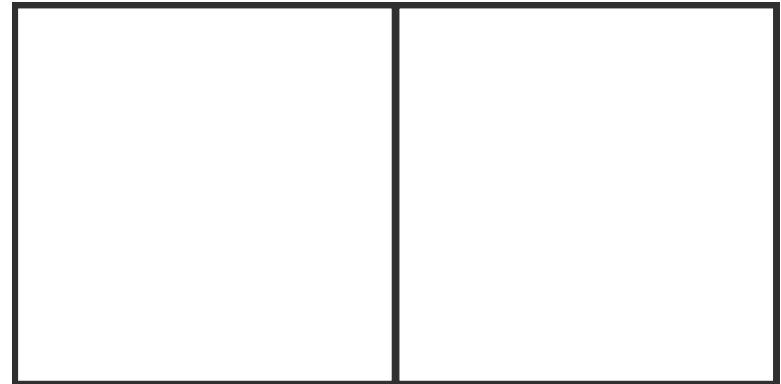

They all dance. But Hedgehog is still sad.

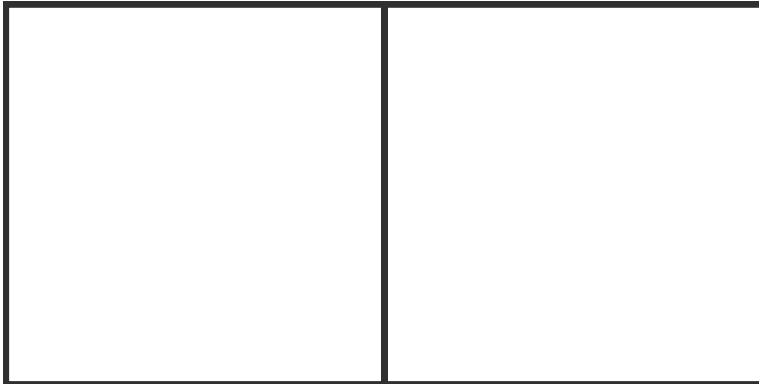

Encouraged by the wise words, the critter crew asks Hedgehog to explain why he is feeling sad.

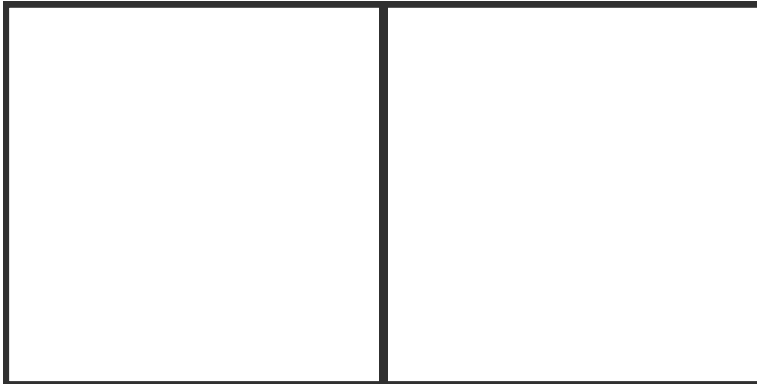
But Hedgehog isn't ready to talk.

"Lets try a sharing circle" Rabbit says. The critters all decide *they* will talk. Each critter will each share something positive and negative about their day.

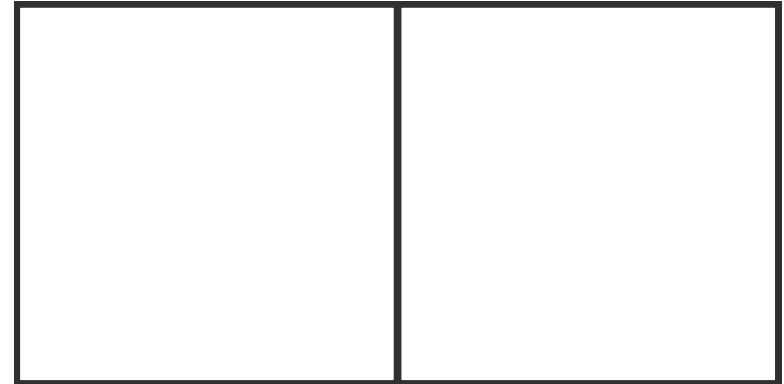

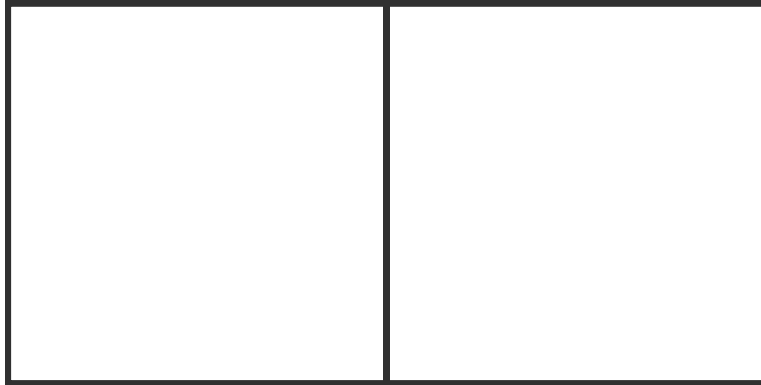
Rabbit says: "My garden is growing beautifully. But bugs ate all of my lettuce."

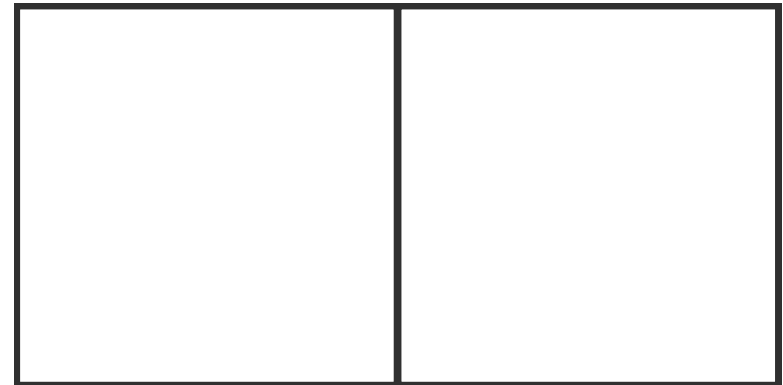

Squirrel contributes: "I climbed further out on a long tree branch than I ever have before. But then it snapped and I fell in the pond."

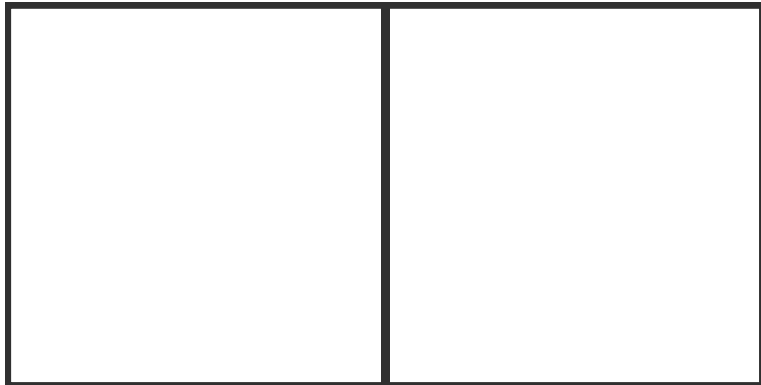
